Quarter-inch head and hood lining is standard on 36" and larger models and is optional on smaller units.

The galvanized construction of Sukup Bucket Elevators ensures that they will last and look good for years to come. Sukup constructs their leg casings using either heavy-gauge huck bolts or seam welding, depending upon the application. Heavy-duty angle iron framework at the head and boot sections add strength, so Sukup Bucket Elevators will stand strong for years to come.
