



**Machinery Product Update:  
Case IH To Build New Puma Series Of Tractors**

Farm Equipment magazine reports:

Case IH said it would start selling a new top-of-the-line 2009 model of Puma Series farm tractors, rated at 195 PTO horsepower.

It said the Puma 225 model vehicle would be assembled with continuously variable transmissions and a standard, switch-activated DieselSaver Auto Productivity Management system.

Other Puma Series tractors include the Puma 165, 180, 195 and 210 model units, spanning a range of 135-180 PTO horsepower.

As reported, Case IH also said it would start selling three new 2009 models of fuel-saving 150-180 horsepower row crop-type farm tractors in North America sourced from a company manufacturing plant here.

It said the Case IH Magnum 180, 190 and 210 model units would expand the Magnum series vehicle lineup to eight models.

Case IH said the three new models of Magnum farm tractors would be powered by 6.75-liter diesel engines with full powershift transmissions and standard Power Boosts. Also standardized is a new switch-activated DieselSaver Auto Productivity Management system.
