New Holland's new line of finishing mowers complements the versatility of New Holland's 28-hp to 60-hp compact and utility tractors. Both the 300 Series rear-mounted finish mowers and 400 Series flex-wing finish mowers are designed for golf courses, parks, or large areas. The 300 Series rear-mount finish mowers are also well-suited to athletic fields, highway maintenance, farming and homeowners.

These finishing mowers feature specially designed cutter head overlap for 100% clean, close cutting. Coupled with high suction cutter blades for lifting the grass, both the 300 Series and 400 Series finish mowers create a clean finish with every cut.

The new 300 Series rear discharge finishing mowers are category 1, 3-point mounted implements for tractors equipped with 540 rpm pto. The mowers are fitted with safety chains and offer cutting widths of 60", 72", and 90".

Three options are available to increase your productivity with these rear discharge finishing mowers, pneumatic tire kit, mulching kit, and anti-scalping kit.

The 400 Series flex-wing finish mowers feature three floating decks with four wheels on each deck. Cutting widths of 12', 15', or 17' are available. Wing decks flex front-to-rear and side-to-side to provide precise mowing and a smooth clean cut for better mowing on uneven terrain.

The flex-wing finish mower is fitted with a tie rod system, automatically keeping the side mowers in vertical position during transport. A transport latching mechanism automatically engages when decks are raised into transport position. Simply pull the release rope to lower the decks.

Standard features for the 400 Series flex-wing finish mowers include hydraulic fold for easy transport and quick and easy height adjustment on each of the independent floating decks for precise cutting on uneven terrain. Front and rear safety chains are standard features. Optional mulching kits are available.
